- b) Oleander Elementary provides materials and training to help parents work with their children to improve their children's achievement as appropriate, to foster parental involvement.
 - Oleander provides strategies to use at home to support their child's academic achievement, such as
 monitoring the completion of homework and school assignments, reading with their child. These
 strategies are highlighted in the Bear Chat, the SSC meetings, Paper Education, access to live virtual
 tutoring through Imagine Math, and the adult education workshops.
 - We show parents how to monitor their children's progress through interpreting state and local
 assessment reports and student progress report, which is discussed during the Bear Chat, the SSC
 meetings, The Adult Education meetings, ELAC meetings, and parent conferences.
 - All communique will be sent translated to the homes.
- c) Oleander Elementary educates teachers, specialized instructional support personnel, principals, and other school leaders, and other staff, with the assistance of parents, in the value and utility of contributions of parents, and in how to reach out to, communicate with and work with parents as equal partners, implement and coordinate parent programs, and build ties between parents and the school.
