Gary Lee Pickett, 76, of Irvine, California, succumbed to cancer on April 22, 2017 after a courageous fight; he was at home surrounded by his loving family.

After retiring from FOHI in 2002, he continued coaching for another 4 years at Santiago Canyon College.

Gary loved to play golf with friends, spend time with family, attend his son's track meets, and take trips with his wife. Most importantly, he touched countless lives with his positive attitude, incredible wisdom, loving heart, and amazing smile. Gary will be missed and loved eternally.
