Howard Proud passed away peacefully at the age of 96 on March 11.

Known as Mr. Proud to most, he was Fontana High School's Agriculture and Future Farmers of America (FFA) advisor from the school's inception in 1952 until retiring in 1983. Also a school athletic enthusiast, he was the official time keeper for varsity football and basketball along with being a CIF baseball umpire for most of those years.

He was the husband to Vivian Proud for 69 years, the brother to six siblings, the father to three children, grandfather to seven grandchildren and great-grandfather to many (still counting) great-grandchildren.

He was a veteran and prisoner of war of World War II. His war years can be read online as documented by his Veterans' History Project, by searching online by his name.

Truly he was one of the Greatest Generation, and mentor to many who will be greatly missed by all.
