



Parents with a social security number should create an FSA ID immediately. According to the Federal Student Aid Commission, parents with an Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) from the IRS may be able to use their ITIN to create an FSA ID in December—more information is expected to be released soon.

Parents who do not have a social security number or an ITIN may need to apply for an ITIN. Again, more information is expected to be released soon. Because this can be a long process, we encourage parents to apply now at: [How do I apply for an ITIN? | Internal Revenue Service \(irs.gov\)](#).
